

How to dispose of domestic garbage (2023 Version)

Please cooperate with separating garbage!



Beverage Cans

* Put into transparent or semi-transparent bags



Glass Bottles

W Put into transparent or semi-transparent bags

Beverage cans (Steel/Aluminum)

Dispose of other metals (e.g. canned goods) as <u>non-burnables</u>.





Empty the cans and rinse thoroughly
You can throw out aluminum and
steel cans together

Glass used for food/drink bottles, spices, makeup, medicine containers

Please put glassware, ceramics, poison/pesticides bottles as non-burnables.







Empty the bottles, rinse, and remove lids
Try to return bottles
(e.g. beer, wine, sake bottles)
back to retailers





Paper and Used Clothing

Paper (newspapers, cardboard, paper cartons, magazines)

- * Please tie paper together before throwing it out.
- · Collected even on rainy days
- You <u>cannot</u> throw out shredded paper as used paper.
 Please bring it to Usuigawa Clean Center (Free-of-charge)
- Please throw out paper cartons with aluminum coating (e.g. Tetra Pak) in burnables.

Scrap paper Newspaper Magazines Ge) Cardboard

Used clothing/fabrics

* Put into transparent or semi-transparent plastic bags and tie it tightly.

- · While it is still collected on rainy days; wet clothing/fabric will not be collected.
- · If you are using the designated garbage bag for burnables, label the bags with "古者" for easy identification.

Local organizations (youth organizations, home owners associations, schools, etc.) collect recyclables (paper and used clothes) from garbage stations located in different districts to raise funds. These collections are scheduled and announced in advanced.

Used Paper

Can be collected

- O Newspaper (including flyers) O Cardboard O Paper cartons
- O Magazines, scrap paper (wrapping paper, pamphlets, etc.)

X Cannot be collected

- Carbon paper (e.g. courier slips) Crimped postcards
- Paper cups, plates Photos Receipts
- Food stained paper Scented papers, etc.

Used Clothing/Fabrics

Can be collected

- O Clothes (T-shirts, jackets, coats, sweaters, jeans, etc.)
- O Underwear, socks (except stockings) O Kimono, obi O Neckties
- O Hats O Backpacks, bags (except for suitcases, student bags "randoseru")
- O Towels, handkerchiefs O Belts O Sheets, curtains (including lace curtains), etc.

X Cannot be collected

- Wet clothing (mold may develop and make the material unrecyclable)
- Stuffed clothing items (hanten, down jackets, etc.) Shoes (sneakers, sandals, etc.)
- Bedding items (e.g. futon, pillows, stuffed blankets)
 Carpets, rugs
- Fabric scraps Stained clothing; clothing with odors Items used for pets...etc.

If it cannot be collected as used clothing/fabric, please throw it out as burnables.(Futons, carpet, etc. over 50 cm are considered as oversized garbage)

Rules for throwing out garbage

- Please throw out garbage before 8:30 am on the day of collection.
 - (Please don't throw out garbage the night before or on non-collection days)
- Garbage over 50cm in size is considered as <u>oversized garbage</u> and <u>cannot</u> be collected. You can bring it to Usuigawa Clean Center (Free if below 50 kgs) If it's difficult to move, contact one of the centers below for assistance.
- · Only residential garbage is collected at the garbage station. Please bring commercial garbage to Usuigawa Clean Center or contact one of the centers below.

Burnables

 \divideontimes Use Annaka City designated garbage bags and tightly secure it. Do not put out more than 5 large sized garbage bags per day.

Leather, rubber

Kitchen waste

Plastics

Remove moisture



Styrofoam, disposable heat packs, ice packs

Non-recyclable paper and fabrics

Branches

Please cut branches to a max length of 50cm and thickness of 5cm. Dry them and put in designated garbage bags. If it is difficult to do so, tie them together to the size of the garbage bag and tie the bag onto the bundle.





Non-Burnables

Put into transparent or semi-transparent plastic bags. (You can throw out glasses and metals together)








For sharp objects and/or broken glass, please wrap it in newspaper before throwing out.

Fluorescents | | | Batteries |

Aerosol cans, cassette gas canisters, HTPs, lighters (Flammables)

Put in <u>transparent</u> or <u>semi-transparent bags</u>. (Separate them from light bulbs and batteries) Aerosol and cassette gas canisters are dangerous, so make sure they're empty. <u>Do not</u> puncture. (If you can't use up all of the contents, please bring it directly to the *Usui Center Center*)

Fluorescent tubes, light bulbs

For safety reasons; please throw it out in its original packaging or wrap it with newspaper.

Tubes longer than 1m cannot be thrown out at the garbage station.

Bring them directly to the Usui Center Center.

Please throw out cracked/broken fluorescent tubes, light bulbs as non-burnables.

Batteries

Please put in <u>transparent</u> or <u>semi-transparent bags</u>.

Rechargeable batteries (e.g. Lithium, button cell batteries) cannot be collected.

Please bring those to collection centers (certain stores) that have recycling stations.

How to Dispose of Recyclable Garbage (Collection Stations)

INK CARTRIDGES

Used ink cartridges from home printers can be recycled

- * All brands of cartridge are accepted as long as it is made for use in Japan
- * Non-genuine branded cartridges are also accepted
- X Toner cartridges are not accepted

SMALL HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES

Electrically or battery powered electronics. This includes remote controls, AC adapters, electrical cords, chargers, etc. Can be recycled if within the size of the entrance of the recycle box (width of 30 cm × length of 15 cm).

There is a designated box for cellular phones and smartphones; within the size of the entrance of the recycle box (width of 10 cm × length of 5 cm). * Please take batteries out * Please erase any personal information Collection locations: Annaka City Hall, Matsuida Branch Office, Usuigawa Clean

USED COOKING OIL

Put used cooking oil in plastic bottles (Max of 2 litres); seal tightly so oil will not leak out. (Glass bottles of cooking oil is not accepted so pour them into plastic bottles for disposal.)



Accepted oils

Used cooking oil from households (e.g. salad, rapeseed, sesame, corn, sunflower, soybean, rice, and olive oil) X Non-accepted oils

Lard, butter, fish oil, engine oils, kerosene oil, certain plant oils (e.g. palm oil, coconut oil)

RECYCLING STATION FOR PLASTIC BOTTLES AND/OR BEVERAGE CANS

There are 21 recycling machines within the city and 5 machines that can take large quantities of plastic bottles. By using your Eco Community (エコ・コミュニティ) card, you can earn points that can be redeemed and used in participating shops (500 points = 400 yen). You get 1 point for every beverage can or plastic bottle recycled.
