From April 1, 2026, a revision to traffic rules will introduce a fine system (blue ticket) for bicycle traffic violations. This means that if you commit certain violations, you will be subject to punishment, but you can be exempt from criminal penalties by paying a fine. The law applies to people aged 16 and over, and covers 113 types of violations, with fines ranging from 3,000 to 12,000 yen.
