
About correspondence to COVID-19 infection after May 8, 2023

(Date of renewal: April 27, 2023)

From May 8, 2023 (Monday), the position of COVID-19 infection diseases under the Infectious Diseases Control Law will be changed to Class 5 infectious diseases. The main measures after the change, especially the concept of the period of medical treatment, are as follows.

- 1. The government does not uniformly request self-restraint from going out, but it is recommended to refrain from going out until 5 days after onset of symptoms and 24 hours have passed since symptoms subsided. It is also recommended that you refrain from wearing masks or contacting with high-risk people until 10 days have passed.
- 2. The public health center will not identify COVID-19 patients as a "close contact" or ask them to refrain from going out.
